



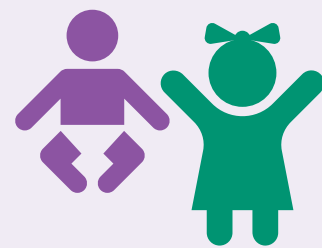

act **FAST** – call 000 (triple zero)



Up to **120 babies**
and **400 children**
have a **stroke** each
year in Australia.



Stroke in **children** and
babies can be missed
because of **lack of**
awareness.



Stroke is **more**
common in **babies**
than older children.



More than **50%** of
children have long
term **neurological**
disability.



Signs of stroke can
be **different** to adults,
especially in **babies.**



Most children are **well**
prior to their **stroke** –
in the remainder, **risk**
factors are **different**
to adults.
