Stroke Foundation has multiple vacancies on its Research Advisory Committee.

We invite expressions of interest from researchers with an established track record in stroke research and/or related fields. We are specifically interested in including members in the following areas, but people with interests in other areas are also welcome to apply:

- › Indigenous health
- › Clinical psychology
- › Medical or nursing specialist in stroke care across acute, sub-acute or transitional care settings

Stroke Foundation is committed to a workplace that champions diversity. In addition to the experience and skills being sought, we encourage applications from suitably qualified people from all cultural backgrounds to apply.

A written application is required to be considered. There is no application form. Your application should include information about:

- › How your experience relates to the areas identified within the EoI call
- › The skills you would bring to the Committee
- › Why you want to join the Research Advisory Committee
- › Your ability to perform the duties and responsibilities outlined in the position description
- › How you will represent the diverse view of our community.

The written application should be no more than two pages long. Please also include a copy of your CV.

Stroke Foundation will consider each applicant's ability to perform the duties and responsibilities in the position description. We will also consider the need to ensure balance in membership, to ensure broad representation of our community, people with lived experience of stroke and fields of stroke-related research.



Stroke Foundation reserves the right to extend the closing date for applications where two nominations are not received for any position sought.

Only short-listed candidates will be contacted for interviews.
