• People who have had a stroke are **more vulnerable** to coronavirus (COVID-19)



People who have had a stroke will be some of the first to be offered the COVID-19 vaccine.





Should I get vaccinated?

 The vaccine is important to stop you getting ill from COVID-19



 The vaccine is important to slow the spread of COVID-19



 The vaccine is safe for people who have had a stroke



 If you have had COVID-19 you still need to get vaccinated



• **Talk to your GP** about the COVID-19 vaccine.



Does the COVID-19 vaccine have side effects?

 The COVID-19 vaccine can cause side effects



The vaccine cannot give you COVID-19



 Ask your GP about the possible side effects of the COVID-19 vaccine.



How do I get the COVID-19 vaccine?





 Talk to your GP about getting the COVID-19 vaccine



You will need 2 doses of the vaccine



 After the first dose an appointment will be made for the second dose


